EXHIBIT A contains the complete chronological evidentiary record documenting the *Three NOTICE Administrative Procedure*, presentments, opportunities to cure, dishonor, default, and perfected obligations occurring between **September 27, 2024**, and **November 13, 2024**.

EXHIBIT A forms a unified **106-page** notarized record establishing the *Three NOTICE Administrative Procedure* sequence of communications, along with the USPS PS Forms 3811 as evidence of defendants' receipt of the same, none of which never received response from *any* Defendant/NAMED party to this Federal Suit.

The record for evidentiary integrity includes:

- *Three NOTICE Administrative Procedure* consisting of COUNTERCLAIM, NOTICE of Dishonor Opportunity-to-Cure, and subsequent Default Judgement;
- Proof of Service, USPS tracking records, certified-mail receipts, and delivery confirmations.

All entries are supported by documentary evidence and postal records within the applicable dates.

Purpose:

To establish, in precise chronological order, that THE CITY OF SNYDER, Inc., personnel, officials, and affiliated actors failed to answer or rebut properly issued *Administrative Procedure* NOTICES, thereby allowing administrative defaults and perfected obligations to attach as of **November 13, 2024**.

This portion of the evidentiary record demonstrates the inception of Defendants' refusal to provide remedy, perform ministerial duties, or comply with required due-process standards—conduct that forms a foundational component of Plaintiff's federal claims under Civil Rights Acts of 1866, Civil Rights Acts of 1871, (42 U.S.C. § 1983).
