Purpose:

The record demonstrates that each party received **(1)** individualized NOTICE, **(2)** an opportunity for exoneration, and **(3)** a clear, lawful path to extinguish their personal obligation before the deadline of **January 31, 2025**.

Summarization:

This Exhibit documents the formal tendering of *individualized Olive Branch Offers* to all named Public Servant Fiduciary TRUSTEES, establishing the final opportunity for mitigation before foreclosure of the perfected obligation.

All parties failed to act, thereby sustaining the administrative default and preserving the evidentiary record supporting the federal claims.
