1. PRIVATE TRUST CAPACITY

All acts referenced in the accompanying *Petition to Answer Legal – Federal Question* are performed in my exclusive capacity as Trustee **For: Sojourn Bequest Irrevocable Trust (SBIT) On Behalf and Benefit of:** Sundual Reparations Irrevocable Trust (SRIT)—acting under trust law, not in any personal or commercial capacity. Trustees acting within their fiduciary role are entitled to near-absolute immunity from suit for official acts (**Barton v. Bar**, 104 U.S. 126, 128–29 (1881); **In re Cir. City Stores**, 557 B.R. 443, 447 (E.D. Va. 2016)).

2. CONSTITUTIONAL PROTECTIONS

- **First Amendment:** The right to petition governmental bodies is fundamental and protected—even if issues concern private trusts (**Right to Petition Clause; Duryea v. Guarnieri**, 143 S. Ct. 1555 (2023)).
- **Fifth Amendment:** Deprivation of property or rights without due process is unlawful and actionable.
- **Eighth Amendment:** Prosecution or punitive response for lawful trust activities is constitutionally barred.
- **Ninth & Tenth Amendments:** Reserve private rights and non-delegated powers to the sovereign people.

3. CIVIL RIGHTS STATUTES

Any retaliatory act or wrongful interference by a public official violates federal law and can give rise to civil action:

- **42 U.S.C. § 1983** – liability for persons acting under color of law who deprive individuals of constitutional rights.
- **42 U.S.C. §§ 1985–86** – allows claims for conspiracy to interfere with rights.



III. CIVIL RIGHTS ENFORCEMENT AGAINST PUBLIC OFFICIALS

8. 42 U.S.C. §§ 1983, 1985, and 1986

- **§ 1983:** Permits civil suits against government actors for deprivation of constitutional rights under color of law.
- **§ 1985:** Prohibits conspiracy to interfere with civil rights (including retaliation against trustees exercising lawful duties).
- **§ 1986:** Imposes liability on officials who knew of such conspiracies and failed to prevent them.

IV. ADDITIONAL SUPPORTING CASE LAW

9. Nieves v. Bartlett, 587 U.S. 1 (2019):

- A claim for retaliatory arrest can proceed even where probable cause exists, provided there is evidence of retaliatory motive.


10. Mt. Healthy City Board of Ed. v. Doyle, 429 U.S. 274 (1977):

- **Mixed motive doctrine:** If part of the reason for a government actor's behavior is retaliation against lawful conduct, it is unlawful even if other motives exist.

ATTACHMENT A

LEGAL AUTHORITY FOR TRUSTEE IMMUNITY AND CONSTITUTIONAL PROTECTIONS AGAINST RETALIATION

I. CONSTITUTIONAL AUTHORITY – PROTECTION AGAINST GOVERNMENT RETALIATION

1. First Amendment – Petition Clause

- *Borough of Duryea v. Guarnieri*, 564 U.S. 379 (2011): Protects the right to petition government for redress of grievances, including by public employees and fiduciaries.
- *Heffernan v. City of Paterson*, 578 U.S. 712 (2016): Retaliation against an individual for perceived engagement in protected activity is actionable.
- *Pickering v. Board of Education*, 391 U.S. 563 (1968): Government cannot retaliate against individuals for speech on matters of public concern.

2. Fifth Amendment – Due Process Clause

- Prohibits deprivation of liberty or property without due process of law. Any adverse action based on lawful trust administration constitutes a deprivation of property (obligations administered) and liberty (trustee functions) without process.

3. Eighth Amendment – Excessive Fines and Punishment

- *Austin v. United States*, 509 U.S. 602 (1993): Prohibits punitive state action that is grossly disproportionate and nonjudicially imposed.

4. Ninth & Tenth Amendments

- Protect residual rights of the People and trust instruments not specifically delegated to federal or state governments, reinforcing private sovereignty over trust administration.

II. FIDUCIARY PROTECTION AND TRUSTEE IMMUNITY

5. Barton v. Bar, 104 U.S. 126 (1881):

- A trustee appointed under judicial authority is immune from suit unless leave of court is granted. This case defines the modern “Barton Doctrine,” shielding fiduciaries from unauthorized legal attack.

6. In re Circuit City Stores, 557 B.R. 443 (E.D. Va. 2016):

- Applied Barton to trust-based asset management. Liquidating trust administrators are immune unless directly breaching fiduciary duty.

7. Butz v. Economou, 438 U.S. 478 (1978):

- Federal officials acting in a quasi-judicial role (such as fiduciaries or private trust officers engaging public agencies) are immune from civil suits unless clearly acting outside legal authority.



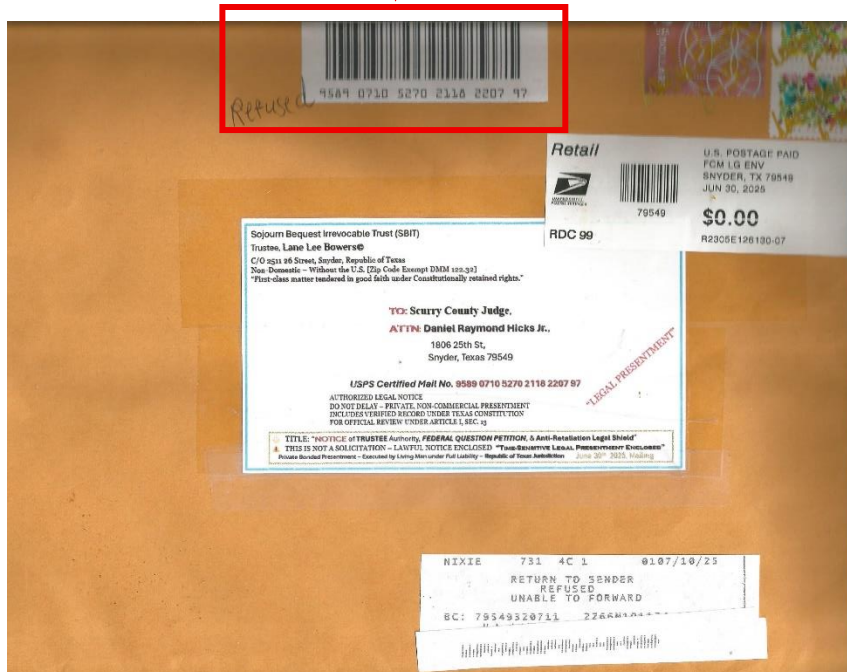
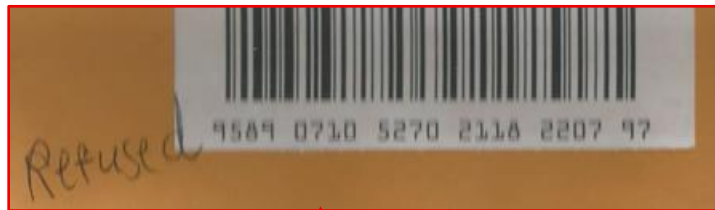
